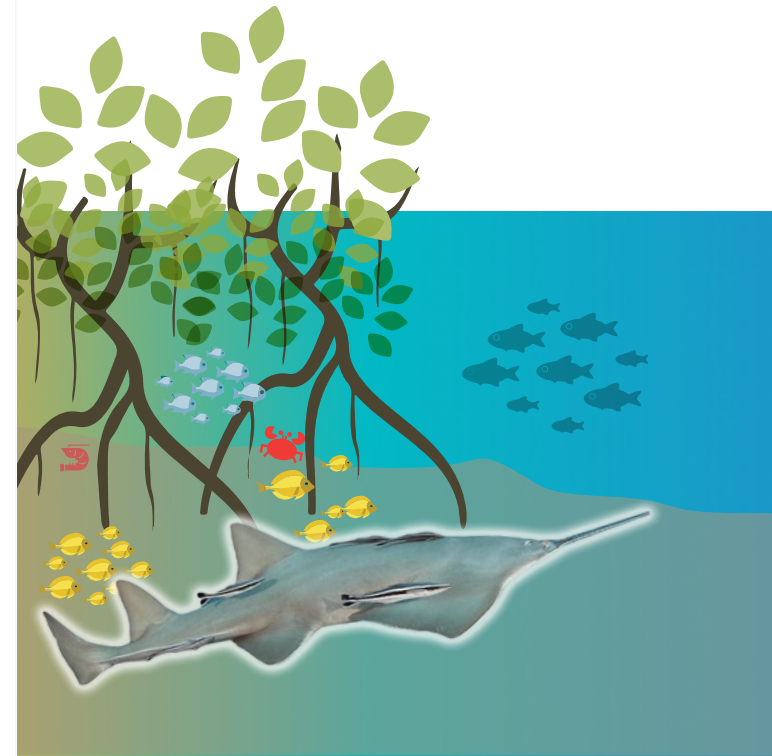


We can help these amazing animals recover by safely releasing any sawfish that are accidentally caught and protecting their mangrove and coastal habitats.

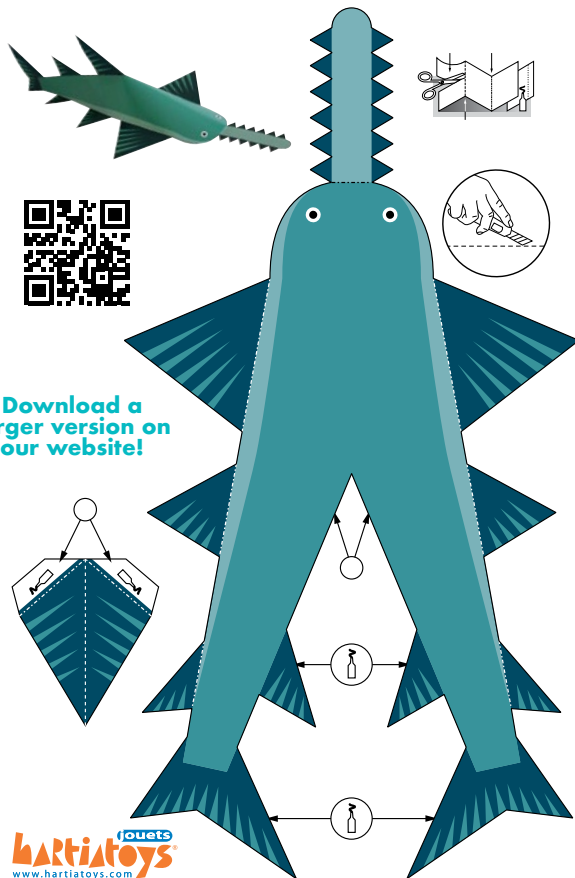


# RELEASE & REPORT

It is important to quickly release and report any sawfish you see to your local fisheries group.

Practice by playing 'Sawfish Hide and Seek'

1. Cut out and build the sawfish below
2. Have a friend hide the sawfish and start a timer
3. Find the sawfish, and then release it by hiding the sawfish for your friend to find
4. Report to your friend where you found the sawfish and stop the timer. Then have them look for the sawfish. Compare times to see who can find and release the sawfish the fastest.

Keep sawfishes environment clean and free of trash

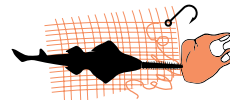

## HOW TO PLAY

Roll dice or pick numbers 1 - 6 from a hat, and travel through the board.



Land on a **TAIL** of freely swimming sawfish, travel **UP** sawfish



Land on the **TIP** of an entangled sawfish, travel **DOWN** sawfish.



Pick up trash to move ahead **5** places.
